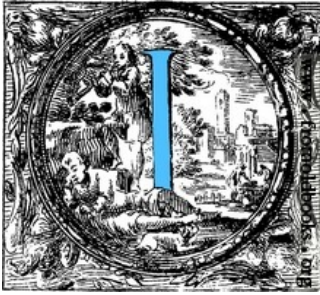


Space Boy (Review)
